SKYLINE HOSPITAL'S ANNUAL HEALTH FAIR RETURNS OCTOBER 7 & 8

WHITE SALMON, Wash. –Skyline Hospital is celebrating its 34th year of providing low and no-cost health screenings to communities throughout the Gorge. This year's community health fair will be held Friday, October 7 and Saturday, October 8 from 7 – 11 a.m., in the hospital's downstairs meeting space.

Free screenings include blood pressure, height, weight and balance testing. For a \$40 fee participants can have blood drawn for testing that includes a blood chemistry screening and lipid panel. Men can include a test for prostate specific antigen (PSA) for an additional \$20. Also, a thyroid stimulating hormone (TSH) test can be included for an additional \$20. All fees must be paid by check or cash and a 12-hour fasting is recommended for those having blood drawn.

Pre-registration is strongly recommended for the blood chemistry screening by calling 509-493-1101 by September 30. Drop-ins are welcomed on a first come, first serve basis.

A healthy breakfast will be served, as well as nutritious snacks. The health fair will also feature local organizations who will provide educational information on a variety of health-related topics. For more information, contact Debi Budnick at 509-637-2601.
